- Effective communication and interpersonal skills that allow effective interaction with clients, agencies, co-workers and the public
- Communicate with design team members, manage tasks and scheduling of junior staff
- Professional oversight of junior staff, collaboration on design, redlines, reviews, overseeing the technical execution of work products
- Knowledge of local land use regulations and the ability to interpret land use language
- Assist in the development of programs, schematics, and concepts in collaboration with junior staff
- Assist in, or develop construction specifications and construction details
- Perform construction on-site supervision, review shop drawings, submittals and RFI's
- Participation in client meetings, public consultations, and presentations
- Other duties as assigned

Education, Experience, Desired Qualifications:

- Bachelor's degree or master's degree in landscape architecture from a college or university accredited by the Landscape Architectural Accreditation Board (LAAB).
- Five or more years of experience in the fields of site planning, site design, and landscape design.
